DAY 1: PEACE IN THE LAND

Pray for peace within Israel's borders and between its neighbors. Reflect on Psalm 122:6, praying for harmony and the safety of its inhabitants.

SCRIPTURE: Psalm 122:6-9

"Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: May those who love you prosper; may there be peace within your walls, prosperity within your fortresses." Because of my brothers and friends, I will say, "Peace be with you." Because of the house of the LORD our God, I will seek your good."

PRAYER:

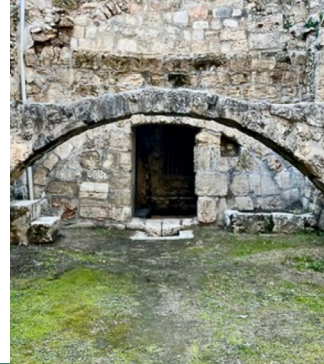

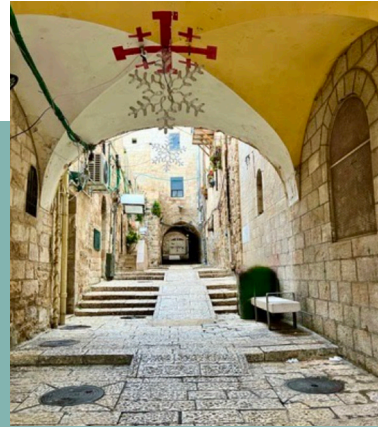

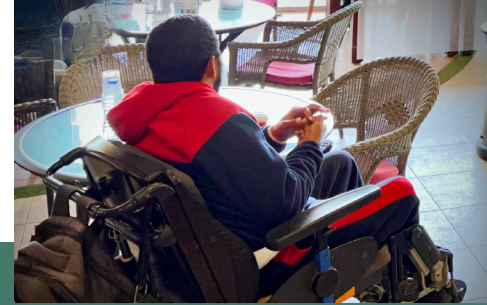


DAY 13: SOCIAL JUSTICE

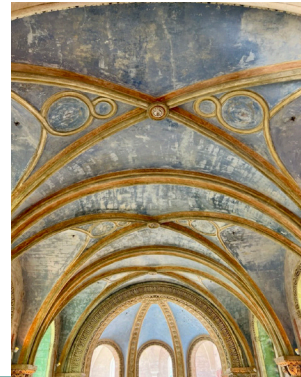

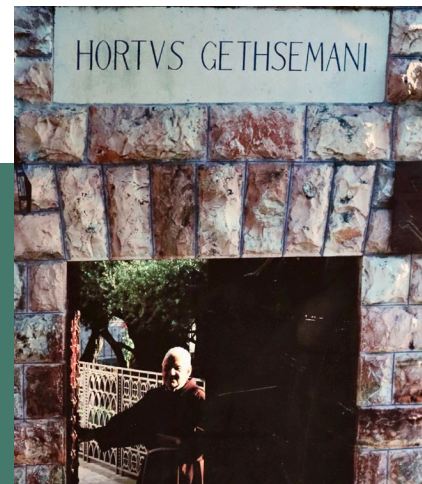

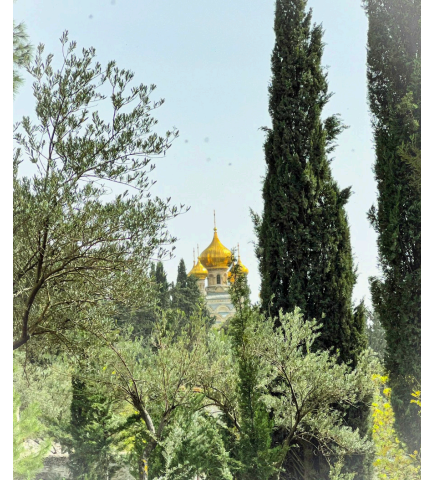

Heavenly Father,

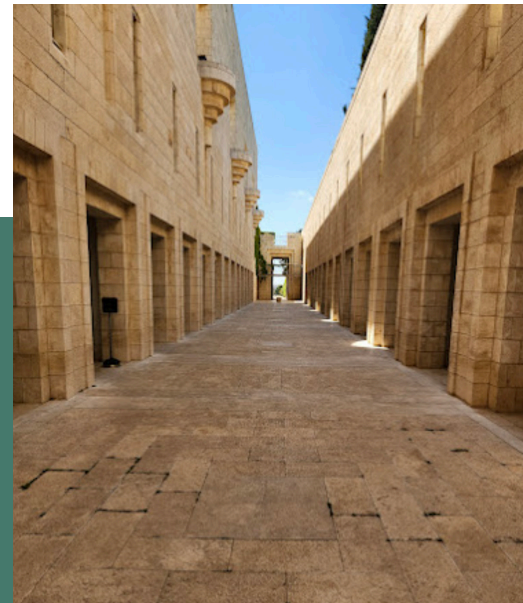
